

INSTALLING OCTAVE DELUXE

The Octave Deluxe plug-in works on computers equipped with: Windows 7 or later and macOS 10.10 or later. You can use the Octave Deluxe plug-in as an Audio Unit or VST2 & VST3 plug-in (32 or 64-bit only)

If you need a different version of Octave Deluxe than the one you've purchased, please email support with the specific version you need.



1.1 Installing Octave Deluxe on PC

Download and extract the Octave Deluxe PC installer.

("Octave Deluxe 32 Bit Setup.exe" for 32 Bit or "Octave Deluxe 64 bit setup.exe" for 64 bit).

Depending on what version of the VST you are using, the location of the Octave Deluxe plugins can be found here:

For VST:

C: /Program Files/Vstplugins/Sauceware Audio/ "Octave Deluxe.dll" and "Octave Deluxe.instruments (Symlink)"

For VST3:

C:/Program Files/Common/VST3/Sauceware Audio/ "Octave Deluxe.VST3" and "Octave Deluxe.instruments (Symlink)"

After installing do not move these files to another location, or it will break the plugin.

After installation is complete, you can now open up your DAW and scan for new plugins. Make sure the correct search path for your plugin folder is selected in your DAW.

FL STUDIO USERS

Please use the VST (vst2.4) version inside of the DAW.

For VST (vst2.4) in some DAW's you may need to add a new location to the "VST Plugin Path" for it to show up. Email support@saucewareaudio.com if you run into any issues.



1.2 Installing Octave Deluxe on MAC

Download and unzip the Octave Deluxe MAC installer (AU or VST)

Logic only works with the AU version of Octave Deluxe.

All other DAW's (Ableton, FL20, etc) will run both AU and the VST version of Octave Deluxe.

1.3 MAC Gatekeeper Solution:

You must use "Ctrl-Click" & Click "Open" in the "Dropdown Menu" Or Use the "Mouse Right Click" & Click "Open" in the "Dialog Box" This will Bypass the "Gatekeeper" and Install the Product: if you do not do this the installer will be Blocked by the "Gatekeeper".



If you do not do this, the installer will be Blocked by the Gatekeeper and you'll see an image like this



The Installer: Follow the instructions inside the Octave Deluxe AU or VST installer. The installer will put Octave Deluxe in the correct folder depending on the version you're installing.

AU plugins will be installed inside: HD/Library/Audio/Plug-Ins/Components

VST plugins will be installed inside: HD/Library/Audio/Plug-Ins/VST

You'll need to restart your MAC for the plugin to recognize it.

Rescan for plugins in your DAW of choice and you should see Octave Deluxe by My Best Friend Jacob show up.

If you use Logic and another DAW on the same computer, we suggest only installing the AU version, as this will allow you to open Octave Deluxe in both Logic and other DAW's well, saving on hard drive space.

Install the Octave Deluxe components folder .DLL file and instrument folder to your desired plugin folder.

You can install Octave Deluxe on your external hard drive but we recommend running Octave Deluxe off of your C: drive for the best user experience.

Make sure that the Octave Deluxe .DLL file and instrument folder are installed in the same plugin folder. Octave Deluxe will not load without the instrument folder located in the same location as the .DLL file.

Open up your DAW and scan for new plugins. Make sure the correct search path for your plugin folder is selected in your DAW.

USER INTERFACE FACE

Below is a list of numbers that correlate to the image above and explain what each effect does:

1 - Cutoff

This knob changes the position of the filter. Depending on the filter type you choose you can get rid of high or low end frequencies. For a Drake Type setting, set the filter type on "low pass" and turn the knob to 3 o'clock.

2 - Filter Type

Setting the filter type to low pass will allow the cutoff knob to get rid of high end frequencies

Setting the filter type to high pass will allow the cutoff knob to get rid of low end frequencies

3 - Presets

You can select from over 300 custom made presets.

Hit the left or right arrows to change the preset

Click the preset name to view a dropdown menu

4 - Volume

Use this to turn the volume of the plugin up and down.

IMPORTANT: The software, when used in combination with an amplifier, headphones or speakers, may be able to produce sound levels that could cause permanent hearing loss. DO NOT operate for long periods of time at a high level or at a level that is uncomfortable. If you encounter any hearing loss or ringing in the ears, you should consult an audiologist.

5 - Vinyl

Turning up this knob changes the speed of the vinyl effect

6 - Vinyl Depth

Turning up this knob raises the amount of vinyl effect is added to the sound

For a "vintage" sounding effect turn the vinyl to 8 o'clock and the vintage depth to 10 o'clock

7 - Reverb

Turn this knob to add reverb to your preset. For hype, pop-type beats turn this knob to the max.

8 - Attack

This will change the shape of the sound. The more you turn up the attack the longer the sound will take to fade in.

9 - Release

This knob changes the release of the sound.

10 - Glide

Glide bends the pitch of your melodies. Want that Travis Scott sound? Turn the glide to 8 o'clock with a bass preset like "Murda Moog". Legato needs to be turned on for glide to work.

11 - Mono/Poly

Poly means you can play chords

Mono and legato means you can only play single notes. The glide knob controls the amount of pitch-bending happening in between notes.


